Time Trial criteria

When regular competitions are restricted in accordance with Public Health guidelines

Adopted by SN Board 11th January 2022

| Purpose | For records attempt. Must show reasonable chance that record will be broken. | For individual recognized time. Records shall not be accepted. |
| Timing | Electronic, semi-electronic (eg plunger) or manual with a minimum of 3 times per lane | Electronic, semi-electronic (eg plunger) or manual with a minimum of 3 times per lane |
| Officiating | One level 4 or 5 official Four level 2-4 officials Minimum of one senior official from outside the club. | One level 4 or 5 official Four level 2-4 officials If a level 4-5 official is unavailable because of Public Health restrictions, the Time trial may be overseen by a Level 3 official. |
| Gender mixing | Not allowed | Allowed (CSW3.5.2) |
| Swimmers /clubs | Sanction request must list names of swimmer's, existing times, and the record they hope to better. Sanction request must specify club and training group, to ensure compliance with Public Health guidelines. May include more than one club, subject to Public Health guidelines. | Sanction request must specify club and training group, to ensure compliance with Public Health guidelines. May include more than one club, subject to Public Health guidelines. |
| Awards | No awards | No awards |
| Sanction notice | Application for sanction submitted minimum one week in advance. Must be advertised 72 hours in advance. | Application for sanction submitted minimum one week in advance. |
